Coaches/Managers Player Awards and Recognition Guidelines

The Panthers Basketball Club (PBC) strives to provide a fun, family orientated, safe, healthy and learning environment for all players.

Purpose

The purpose of these guidelines is to:

1. Recognise the achievements and participation of players throughout the current playing season
2. Detail criteria and administration arrangements in awarding and recognising player achievements and participation

Guidelines

These Recognition Awards guidelines are designed to give Coaches and Team managers a framework and selection criteria (refer to Appendix A and B attached) to assist them in awarding individual player certificates or trophies.

These Awards and Recognition will be presented at the end of season Presentation/Windup Day as nominated by PBC unless arranged otherwise. Player's names and award details are to be provided by the coaches and or managers to the nominated Panthers Committee member at the conclusion of the normal playing season prior to finals in a timely manner to enable necessary arrangements for Trophies and Certificates to be issued.

It is the responsibility of the team Coaches, team Managers, Club and all Club officials to ensure that all Awards and Recognition are issued fairly.

The structure of the awards is fixed and no variation to the numbers or names of the trophies is permitted without the prior agreement of the Club Executive Committee.

Award Name	Award Type	Eligibility	Award Criteria	Persons Responsible
Coaches Award Certificate	Certificate	Registered players in U8's – U10's age groups only.	<p>An award certificate will be presented to each registered player of each team outlining their core qualities for optimal encouragement of each age group.</p> <p>Consideration should be given to the player's performances throughout the season both at games and training.</p> <p>Reflecting on what the player has personally achieved, rather than in competition with others, should be foremost in determining the award criteria. These awards are to be determined by the Coach and or Manager may include but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Always giving their best • Showing improved skills • Being attentive at training • Listening to instructions • Being a team player etc. <p>A space for the child's name as well as their award criteria will be available for Coaches/Managers to complete prior to the end of the regular season.</p> <p>Coaches will be able to present these certificates to their players at the end of season Presentation/Windup day.</p>	Coaches/ Managers

Award Name	Award Type	Eligibility	Award Criteria	Persons Responsible
Coaches Award Trophy	Trophy	Registered players in the U12's - U18's age groups only	<p>A single trophy will be presented to an individual player.</p> <p>This award is to be determined by the Team Coach and or Manager as recognition of the player's outstanding contribution throughout the competition season, excluding finals. This is not necessarily for playing performance. Some examples of award are Most Improved, Best Team Player or Most Valuable Player. Consideration should be given to the performances throughout the season both at games and training.</p> <p>It can include an assessment of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General consistent participation; • Leadership qualities; • Teamwork. • Game performance • Players importance to team performance <p>This award quite often goes to the player who is not necessarily an outstanding player but is a team player, always at training, listening and trying to put the coach and managers words into action.</p> <p>In the case of the Coach and or Manager wishing to award the trophy as a MVP, this can be done based on their own selection criteria or on the HRBA votes awarded by the umpires or a combination of both.</p> <p>If a player has been found to be guilty of any misconduct by either the PBC or the HRBA at any point throughout the current season, they will no longer be eligible to receive is award.</p> <p>The award cannot be shared unless a sufficient case is put forward to the Committee for approval.</p>	Coaches/ Managers
